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BoT relaxes credit card payment rules

The BoT announced a relaxation of credit card payment rules: 1) it will maintain the rate at 8% until end-2025, 2) give cash back to debtors who can make the 8% minimum payment and 3) provide debt restructuring for those that cannot make the 8% minimum payment. These measures are positive for asset quality at banks and consumer finance companies and will help ease credit cost pressure, particularly for AEONTS (the most) and KTC though at the same time, NIM will take a small hit.

Relaxation of credit card payment rules. The BoT announced a relaxation of credit card payment regulations, detailed below.

- The minimum credit card payment rate will be kept at 8% for another year, until the end of 2025 rather than returning to the original rate of 10% on January 1, 2025, to help reduce the burden of debt repayment and maintain liquidity for households, especially vulnerable groups. The BoT will closely monitor and evaluate the results of the measures to consider the appropriate minimum payment rate later.
- 2) Debtors who make minimum repayments of more than or equal to 8% will receive cash back equivalent to 0.5% interest on the outstanding balance for the first half of the year and 0.25% for the second half of 2025, paid every three months, to encourage them to close their debt faster and have a lower interest burden for the entire contract.
- 3) Debtors who originally paid a minimum of 5% but are unable to pay up to 8% can restructure their debt before it becomes an NPL by changing the type of debt from credit card to a term loan to be paid in installments. Debtors will still be able to access funds up to the remaining credit card limit. The BoT requires credit card operators to offer additional beneficial conditions to debtors, such as reducing interest rates, which the central bank will take action to make effective by September 2024.

Debt consolidation. The BoT is encouraging financial institutions (FIs) to help debtors by greater consolidation of their home loans and retail loans via relaxing the loan-to-value ratio (LTV) conditions in all contracts for debt consolidation to be able to exceed the specified ceiling. The debt consolidation service provider must ensure that the debtor's burden after consolidation is less than before, such as lower interest rates and lower installments than the total installments previously paid. This measure will end in 2025.

Extending persistent debt measures. For debtors with persistent debt problems under the responsible lending scheme, the BoT has extended the debt settlement period from 5 years to 7 years (interest rate not exceeding 15% p.a. as before) in order to reduce the installments that debtors must pay and allow debtors to still obtain funding from the remaining credit line. It also requires service providers to provide additional information to nudge debtors, such as communicating the advantages and disadvantages of debt restructuring and displaying a table of information on the repayment period and interest burden. The measure will be effective from January 1, 2025 onwards.

Implication: Most positive for AEONTS. These measures have a positive implication to asset quality for banks and consumer finance companies, helping to ease credit cost pressure, particularly for AEONTS and KTC, though at the same time, NIM will take a small hit. We believe AEONTS will benefit the most from the relaxation of credit card minimum payment as around 80% of its credit card clients pay only the minimum. AEONTS has already set aside Bt200mn management overlay for the step up in minimum credit card payment to 10%. We now forecast a 25 bps rise in credit cost for AEONTS and KTC in 2025. The postponement of the resumption of 10% minimum credit card payment should allow AEONTS and KTC to maintain or ease their credit cost in 2025. If we lower our 2025F credit cost by 25 bps, there would be an upside on 2025F earnings by 6% for AEONTS and 3% for KTC.


Key risks: 1) Asset quality risk from an uneven economic recovery, 2) credit cost risk from falling used vehicle prices, 3) rising competition from banks, and 4) ESG risk from market conduct and regulatory risk.
